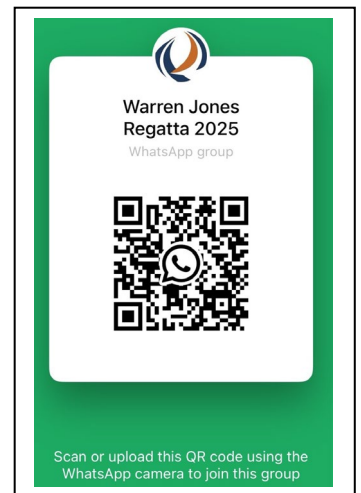

### ACCOMMODATION

#### Pt Walter Recreational Camp – DLGSC

Teams staying at the Point Walter Recreational Camp will receive detailed information about their accommodation prior to arrival. We kindly ask that you review this information thoroughly.

Please note that alcohol, smoking, and vaping are strictly prohibited on the premises.

#### Billett information

Teams billeted with host families or on boats in the marina will also receive information before their arrival.

We ask that all sailors conduct themselves respectfully, both within the host family's home, at the Point Walter Recreational Camp and throughout the community. Please treat our host family, their property, and fellow residents with courtesy, kindness and consideration.

## TRANSPORT

### Uber

Teams staying at the Point Walter Recreational Camp will receive an Uber voucher for transport back to their accommodation after each day of racing, from Monday, 27 January through Friday, 31 January.

### Ferry Service

Teams accommodated at the Point Walter Recreational Camp will be transferred by ferry from the Point Walter Jetty from Monday, 27 January through until Friday, 31 January. Please allow for a 15-minute walk from the Point Walter Recreational Camp dormitories to the jetty each morning. Ferry times as follows:

Monday, 27 January – 09:30 / Tuesday, 28 January – Friday, 31 January 08:00

Most teams billeted are within walking distance to the yacht club. For billeted sailors who are not within walking distance of the Club, an Uber voucher can be provided on request to assist with transport to and from the Club. Uber vouchers will only be available from 27 January – Friday, 31 January. However, some host families will assist with transporting teams to the Club.

### Train Service – To and from the Airport

Each team is responsible for arranging their own transportation to the allocated accommodation. The Sailing Office will coordinate with teams regarding accommodation details.

A train service runs from the airport to Claremont, which is located near the yacht club. The train fare is \$5.10. You may wish to take up this option rather than an uber or taxi. The Train time-table can be found [here](#). Please note the last train departs around 11:30pm.

Hats or headwear shall be removed whilst in the Clubhouse unless worn for approved Club, medical, religious, or cultural reasons.
